ORDER OF SUCCESSION AND THE STATE COUNCIL

TO BE ENFORCED FROM 20TH JUNE 2023
INDEFINITELY

BY ORDER OF WILLOW DZIEDZIC I OF THE STATE OF HOKORIA

SECTION 0

This Order of the Head of State of the State of Hokoria is to be carried out at the highest level of the Central Government of Hokoria and is to be enforced at all times when there is an Office of the Head of State.

SECTION 1

The Head of State of the State of Hokoria should possess the highest position in the State of Hokoria, having complete power and control of the State of Hokoria and its Central Government of Hokoria.

SECTION 2

The Head of State of the State of Hokoria should remain active within the State of Hokoria and should report to the Council of the State.

SECTION 3

The Council of the State should consist of 5 individuals who should advise and support the Office of the Head of State whilst having the authority to appoint a new Head of State of the State of Hokoria.

SECTION 4

The 5 individuals who are members of the Council of the State, or State Council members, should be appointed by the Head of State of the State of Hokoria. They may be appointed for any reason and may have the highest security clearance and access to the Central Government of Hokoria, whilst not having any authority over anyone other than the Head of State of the State of Hokoria. Members do not require citizen status.

SECTION 5

The Council of the State may appoint a new Head of State of the State of Hokoria should all 5 members agree that the current Head of State of the State of Hokoria is unfit to act as the Head of State of the State of Hokoria. They may appoint any individual who they all agree on, who should be granted all the tools and authority as the previous Head of State of the State of Hokoria.

SECTION 6

After the Founder, Willow Dziedzic I, is removed from their position as the Head of State of the State of Hokoria, they lose their authority and powers but must join the Council of the State as a sixth member.

SECTION 7

The Council of the State should organise a ceremony where the new Head of State of the State of Hokoria should read the following oath aloud in public:

I, as Head of State of the State of Hokoria, do swear to devote myself to the oversight of the State of Hokoria and the protection of its people. I will assume my place in the Office of the Head of State and act only to benefit my people.

SECTION 8

The Central Government of Hokoria must always report to the acting Head of State of the State of Hokoria rather than the founder, should the founder cease to be the Head of State of the State of Hokoria.
