Terms

By submitting a response to the General Census of 2024, individuals agree to our Terms and Privacy Statement. Respondents confirm that the information provided within the General Census of 2024 is correct to the best of their knowledge, acknowledging that a charge of up to 20.00 EUR may be issued where incorrect information has been submitted, as well as the removal of citizen status as according to the Act of Citizenship (2023). Respondents confirm that they are aged 13 or over, and where aged under 18 have received the consent of someone who has parental responsibility for them to consent on their behalf. Respondents agree to their information being anonymously published by the Royal Government of Hokoria.

Privacy Statement

The data submitted by individuals will be collected and stored in a secure spreadsheet managed by the Department of the Interior and the Royal Office. We will retain personal, identifiable information for up to 30 days before removing any identifiable information and anonymising any additional information. We will not collect the data of individuals aged 12 or under and are collecting the data of individuals aged 17 or under with parental consent as required by general data protection regulation (GDPR). The data submitted by individuals may be used within the Department of the Interior's Central Registry of Information to update existing or missing records.
